

Dear Friends,

We finished off the year 2023 in the Academy with a Christmas party. This is generally one of my favorite days of the school year. It is always fun to see students in a different light-dressed in different clothing styles, playing games, with no concern about academics for one day out of the year. Many of our games and activities vary de-



pending on the year, but a Lighthouse tradition is to play a game called "Four on a Couch". This is a game of strategy, memory, and secret identities, where students sit in a circle, exchange names, and battle using code names to get their own team to have complete control of four cherished seats known as, "The Couch". If you are unable to recall your teammates by their code names, you very easily will make mistakes that could cost your team a victory. This sounds easy enough, but it is amazing how difficult it can be in the moment of pressure when you are in the "seat of power".

The last aim of this game is a spiritual message, but as I contemplate it, there is a pretty cool analogy to our spiritual walk. You and I are on this journey called life, and we spend every day making decisions, trusting people, or choosing to avoid situations, all with the aim of achieving that end goal of eternity in Heaven. However, so many people seem to struggle with what the strategy looks like on this end of eternity to reach that final destination. The more I learn the heart of God, the easier it can be to recognize my allies, and the pitfalls to avoid, and they may not be what you expect. This is not based on the name they answer to, such as the game described above, as there are many who *claim* Christ as Christians, but fail to *know* Him. However, those who have truly tak-

en the identity of Jesus, in word and deed, prove themselves to be comrades as we pursue this Great Commission. The challenge lies in the fact that many try to play this part, but misunderstand Jesus. Jesus was a man of compassion, love, and truth. He never endorsed sin, but did not berate the sinner. He was not trying to build church membership, or to generate a large tithe check. His motives were to be real, exposing hypocrisy, and doing the will of Father God.

Jesus had those He called disciples, but even those who by name were on His team denied, doubted, and betrayed Him. He had crowds that shouted His name in expectation, but when things were different than they thought, they also turned on Him. And yet, upon all of these people, He had compassion... He showed love, grace, and patience. Most of them came around, but some did not. As I study Scripture, I see God using people to further His Kingdom that I would not have expected... people like the Samaritan woman, Rahab the prostitute, Saul the church persecutor, and Peter the fisherman. At the same time, Jesus failed to use the rich young ruler who had kept every commandment since his youth, or many of the church leaders of the day. I pray that 2024 becomes the year that we clearly see people through a new set of lenses. I pray that we can work together as the church to challenge and encourage, producing fruit that lasts 'til eternity! -Pastor Jacob Masemore




